

Tender responds to APPG's six recommendations for the prevention of child sexual abuse

Last year the Child Protection All Party Parliamentary Group (APPG) asked Tender's director, Susie McDonald, to take part in a seminar series focusing on ways to prevent child sexual abuse. The APPG has now released their report which contains six recommendations for the Government. We are happy to provide a link to the full report published on the NSPCC website:
