It was incredibly comforting to know she was thinking of me.

On returning home, after my duties, it became clear that the process of sending a parcel had also meant a lot to my family and friends. They felt they could connect with me despite being thousands of miles away. I have kept every parcel and letter I received during my time in Afghanistan. I occasionally go through them to remind myself of how much support I received while overseas.

Fast forward six years and the skills and experience I gained in the RAF have helped me to build a new career with Tesco. I now work in our Head Office supporting store colleagues across the country. My memory of opening that parcel from my Mum means I'm particularly proud of Tesco's partnership with the British Forces Post Office (BFPO).
