

The Indie Farmer Sets Out on Indiegogo Crowdfunding Road Trip to Help Independent Farmers and Small Food Producers

Nigel Akehurst, farmer's son, photographer and founder of startup online magazine indiefarmer.com, based in Hackney London, is going on a six week UK road trip on his 125 Vespa scooter 'Veronica'. The aim of the trip is to connect a growing audience of people who care where their food comes from, with independent farmers and small producers. Nigel will visit and showcase these 'indie farmers' via a series of interviews and picture stories on his blog and a special print edition of Indie Farmer launching in late autumn.
