4. MEAT Leeds at MEATIIquor – A special Leeds inspired food and drink combo featuring 'gravy fries' and unique cocktails for £6.*MEATIquor, May 22 – June 7.*

5. Leeds Loves Cocktails – 38 cocktail bars in the city are collaborating to promote the best mixed drinks over a week of events, tastings and special sessions. *Various, June 1 – 7.*

6. Thai Cooking School – Discover the art of Thai cooking and culture, then use your new found knowledge to prepare unique dishes before sitting down to enjoy the fruits of your labour. *Chaophraya, May 30.*

7. Handmade Yorkshire – Some of the finest chefs from around the region will be hosting exciting cookery demonstrations alongside mark stalls and live entertainment. *Victoria Gardens, June* 5 – 7.
