

# UK Challenge announce Teenage Cancer Trust as their exclusive charity partner

- The partnership will aim to better the £300k raised by the event competitors in 2018
- UK Challenge and Teenage Cancer Trust will work closely on many fundraising initiatives with a goal to fund at least six Teenage Cancer Trust specialist Lead Nurses for a year.
