Most of the action takes place at the Theatre by the Lake, sited right on the edge of Derwentwater. There are talks, lectures, discussions, workshops and special exhibitions.
- 4. **Beatrix Potter Gallery** Beatrix Potter, author of the popular children's book Peter Rabbit, artist, major landowner and business woman is one of the region's most admired residents and 2016 is the 150th anniversary since her birth. The Romance and Realism exhibition takes place 12 Mar 6 Nov and is an exhibition of Beatrix's original watercolours and illustrations which explore the inspiration she found in the natural world.
