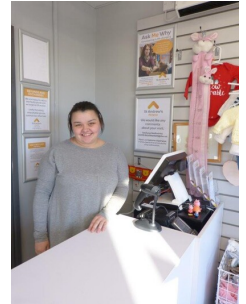
She said: "I came out of college and could not get a job.
