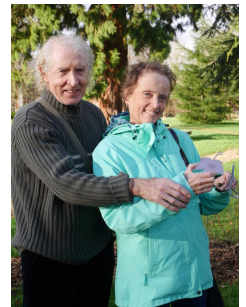

It provides a quiet space to enjoy a moment of peaceful reflection. Leaves are available to purchase for £100 and will hang on the tree for 12 months.
