

Winners announced for Pearson's ELT Teacher Award 2017

Wednesday 25th January 2017: Pearson, the world's leading education company, announce the winners of their first Global ELT Teacher Award.

A winner, the entrant with the most votes in each region, will receive 20 Kindles for their class, pre-loaded with Pearson content. Voting for this prize was open for four weeks and received a staggering 34,300 votes.
