The eligibility requirements were any and all UK companies which had turned over more than a certain amount a year, but no maximum, thus permitting start-ups and scale-ups of all sizes to compete.

UK business owners and entrepreneurs converged at the Sky Garden for the Business Leader Growth500 Awards. The building is commonly referred to as the "Walkie Talkie" skyscraper. The evening was one of inspiration and recognition for some of the UK's most exciting businesses.
