A total of £11,628 has been raised through staff events, participation in the Hospice's Corporate Challenge event and regular donations.

Yeates' distinctive lorries also help out at CHSW events such as the Rainbow Run and Santa's on the Run by providing transport and even a helping hand from James himself.

He added: "We are a family-run firm that has been operating in the area for more than 100 years and it is very rewarding for us to support a local charity which does such important work."

Janey Hellman, CHSW's Corporate Partnerships Fundraiser said: "Yeates has been a huge supporter of Children's Hospice South West starting with our appeal to build Charlton Farm, our local hospice in Wraxall, back in 2006.
