By embedding youth work into hospital settings, the partnership has reduced re-admissions, supported young people to recover more sustainably, and provided a bridge between medical services and community-based care.

The hospital youth work team at Young Gloucestershire works closely with children, young people, and their families during some of the most challenging periods in their lives. By addressing practical and emotional needs, signposting to additional support, and offering a consistent presence, the team ensures that no young person feels alone or unsupported.
